Missions Building Perspective

A number of things have come together in the last few weeks that makes it look like this summer will experience some construction dust as the present Missions Building is demolished and work begins on the new structure.

▶ Final revisions are coming together so we can apply for building permits in the next few weeks.

Then, depending on the permit process . . .

▶ Demolition can begin on the current building . . .

▶ Followed by site preparation and concrete work so that . . .

▶ Crews can begin setting up the steel structure with materials expected to be delivered in July.

So, what will that mean for our Camps and Conferences that traditionally meet in the Missions Building?

We are currently planning to move those sessions into a large tent on the grounds. We encourage participants to pack an extra lawn chair and an umbrella.

Keep checking the Camp's website for updated construction information. Please continue to pray with us as this project comes together and as we look forward to how God can use this facility as a resource to build up and encourage His people.
